COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 7

**ENDORISING THE BLACK CARBON OR BLACK SOOT MITIGATION PROJECT
OF COMMISSIONER HEHERSON T. ALVAREZ**

WHEREAS, the Commission is in the process of implementing the National Climate Change Action Plan;

WHEREAS, the Commission has adopted the principle of collegiality in its basic operations to facilitate the process and to cover all significant sectors of the nation;

WHEREAS, the Philippines has a unique opportunity to help diminish pollution, particularly the so-called black carbon created by diesel-fueled vehicles and generators and which has extraordinary climate change inducing effects, through a special mitigation program.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved during the Commission Meeting held on 25 March 2013, that:

1. The Commission officially recognizes and endorses the black carbon or black soot mitigation project being developed by the private sector and encouraged by the Office of Commissioner Heherson T. Alvarez;
2. The Commission shall extend support to this project as may be deemed necessary upon request but subject to policy constraints;
3. The Commission shall be provided regular updates and reports by the Office of Commissioner Alvarez whose area of responsibility covers this black carbon mitigation initiative.
